

Old Main Clock, Founded on Refunds Of Damage Fees, Again Tolls in Tower

Although cabages and kings have been closely associated in fiction, the incongruous distinction of having been founded on damage fee refunds remains to the clock re-installed in Old Main this fall.

To J. H. Painter '04 belongs the credit for the original suggestion that each member of his class subscribe the \$3.50 remaining from a \$5 damage fee at the close of the year. Although Old Main tower had been planned at the time of rebuilding in 1896 to accommodate a clock, no money had been available for the time piece.

When Painter broached his suggestion to unsympathetic class members, he met rejection after rejection, until finally he gave up in disgust.

C. S. Bomberger, another member of the class, took up the cause, and carried it through until he had obtained the necessary amount.

Three years later, in May of 1904, Bomberger wound up the clock, gave the pendulum its first push, and both the clock and Painter's plan of using the damage fee refund for class memorials were started on their successful careers.

A terrace for Old Main, the pipe organ in Schwab auditorium, the front campus wall and gateway, a winter sports park and a skating rink are listed among the projects presented through the same system by other classes, although the present damage fee has been reduced to one dollar a year.

Four additions were made to the staff at the same time. N. A. Heddon, W. J. Jennings, and Harry R. Dowdy, Jr. '30 were named instructors while Frank C. Stewart became assistant professor in mechanical engineering.
