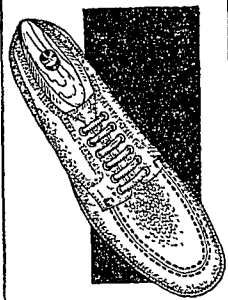
Members of the debating squad will meet in room 1 North Liberal Arts at 7:00 o'clock Tuesday night.
