

### LION TENNIS TEAM BEATS GETTYSBURG

#### Rolls Up 8-1 Tally Against Bullet Netmen in Season's First Matches Saturday

Penn State's tennis team defeated Gettysburg 8-to-1 in the first match of the season here Saturday. A crowd of about two hundred people watched the Lions demonstrate their superiority by winning all but two of the contests in straight sets.

Zeigler, Bullet captain and first ranking player, was the only battlefield man to turn in a win. He took a three-set battle with Robinson, displaying a steady game of tennis, especially in the deciding frame, when he rolled up an early lead.

Thompson's drives were too much for the chopping style of Stock, and McKune won easily from Boyer. McCabe had little difficulty in disposing of Wolf in the fourth set, while Schaeffer encountered more resistance in Robb. Carter was extended to an extra set to defeat Livingood in the final singles match.

In doubles, the Thompson-McKune, Cutting-McCabe, and Robinson-Fietz combinations won over Zeigler-Stock, Robb-Barclay, and Livingood-Aumiller, respectively, with little trouble except in the first contest. All took their matches in straight sets.

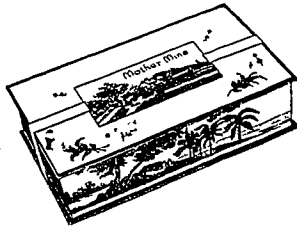
