

STICKMEN OPPOSE INDIANS TOMORROW

Lion Lacrosse Team Will Meet Onondaga Twelve Here On Beaver Field

Engaging in their fourth contest of the season, a Penn State lacrosse twelve will meet the Onondaga Indians on New Beaver field at 1 o'clock tomorrow afternoon.

Handicapped in practice this week by rainy weather, Coach Ernie Paul will start Gwynn at goal with McMullan and Day at point positions. Houck, Decker, and Andrews compose the Lion defense for the game. Edell or Smith will play at center and either Smith or Croner is scheduled for third attack. Carlson will play in the second attack post with Lewis, with either Weber or Crooke completing the Lion

line-up at the homes. Others who will probably enter the game are Kaiser and Zimmerman, defense, and Henry and Keeler, attack men, while Kane may see action at point.

In contests played this season with Penn State opponents, the Onondaga Indians defeated Colgate stickmen, 7-to-2, and lost to Syracuse, 2-to-0. The Indians will attempt to avenge their only defeat last year when the Lions nosed them out, 3-to-2.
