EDITH G. ZINN '32 WINS WOMEN'S TRACK HONORS
 Breaks Century Dash Meet Record. Equals 75-yard Sprint Mark

Edith G. Zinn '32 was high individual scorer in the annual women's track and field meet held Saturday on Holmes field. She broke her own previous meet record in the 100-yard dash, and equaled another mark in the 75-yard sprint.

A former record of 7 feet 10 1/2 inches in the standing broad jump fell before Marie E. McMahon '32, who jumped 8 feet. Dorothy Ward '34 broke an eight-year-old record of 14 feet 6 1/2 inches in the running broad jump. In winning the javelin throw, M. Harriet Allen '34 passed a mark set in 1926, while E. Louise Hoffedtz '31 equalled a former meet record in the high jump, crossing the bar at 53 inches.

Her time of 12 seconds in the century, and 9 seconds in the 75 helped to gain the winner her total of 13 points. Second honors went to McMahon with 11 points, followed by Allen with 10, whose score was raised by winning the shot put. Virginia E. Detweiler '31, who placed fourth, took the 50-yard dash. In the two other events, Alice M. Marshall '33 won the baseball throw and Ellen F. Anderson '31 the basketball toss.

Dean Robert L. Sackett, of the School of Engineering, is to deliver the commencement address at the University of Arkansas today. He will have as his topic, "Society and Science."
