WAR WILL COME, BAKELESS CLAIMS

Mr. Bakeless believes that the most potent combination for war today would be the scientific, well-trained German communists with the Russian Reds, whose resources are limitless, and whose respect for human life is not great.

1912 Conditions Similar
He thinks that the next war will be fought by a professional army, whose tanks, airplanes, and scientific facilities will make a quick business of invasion.

He pointed out that similar situations to the present one existed before the World War. In 1912, he related, Sir Philip Gibbs was called from a strike in England, told that the German and British fleets were ready to fight.
