

### I. M. GRID TOURNEY ENTERS SEMI-FINALS

#### 8 Elevens Play Quarter-Final Tilts—4 Survive After Encounters Tonight

With the close of fourth round games tonight, intramural football competition will advance to the semi-finals Monday night.

Relying exclusively on line plunges, Alpha Chi Sigma downed Tau Kappa Epsilon, 12-to-0, in the opening clash Monday. Chi Upsilon, favored by an intercepted pass, scored 13 points in shutting out Alpha Phi Sigma. Myers, fullback, made both touchdowns. Phi Kappa Sigma overcame Theta Chi, 12-to-0, the same night. Phi Kappa Sigma's heavy line again was responsible for victory. Phi Sigma Kappa, exhibiting a powerful attack, managed to defeat Sigma Phi Epsilon, 6-to-0. The losers showed good form during the opening and closing minutes, but were unable to score.

#### End Fourth Round Tonight

In Tuesday's contests, Sigma Nu, through a strong passing attack, overwhelmed the Independent Cubs by a 37-to-0 tally. Kappa Sigma, scoring on an intercepted pass and resorting to straight line plays, downed Sigma Phi Sigma, 20-to-0.

Scoring as the result of an intercepted pass and a blocked kick, Delta Sigma Phi outplayed Phi Epsilon Phi in a 12-to-0 game the same night. Phi Kappa managed to defeat Lambda Chi Alpha, 7-to-6, in the closing third round game. The losers scored on a long pass in the final period.

Tonight, Sigma Nu will engage Delta Sigma Phi, and Kappa Sigma will play Phi Kappa. Last night, Alpha Chi Sigma and Phi Sigma Kappa, and Chi Upsilon and Phi Kappa Sigma were scheduled to meet.


