

# Lion Soccermen Will Meet Syracuse Here Tomorrow

No New York State team has ever beaten Penn State in soccer. With a resolve to break this record making the powerful Syracuse eleven all the more dangerous, Coach Bill Jeffrey's boosters will have to put "full steam ahead" in order to turn back the Orange team here tomorrow at 12:30 o'clock.

According to the omens, Syracuse should have Dame Fortune on its side. Seven of the eleven men who held the Lions to a scoreless tie last year will again start in the lineup against them tomorrow. But the Nittany-men flashed excellent form last week and if they repeat their performance tomorrow Dame Fortune will double-cross the Orange.
