

EXAMINATION SCHEDULE

Faculty Men Name Lower Golfer's Fee As Recreational Aid

Lower fees for faculty use of the College golf course, and a College-maintained swimming pool are among some of the suggestions made by faculty members as aids to recreation, a survey by Martin S. McAndrews, graduate student, reveals.

More tennis courts about the campus should be provided, faculty opinion shows, and a definite schedule for faculty use should be devised. Locker, towel, and shower facilities are also among the requests.

Faculty members also feel that definite periods should be provided in Recreation hall, at which time instruction would be given professors by regular members of the staff of the School of Physical Education and Athletics.

One popular request revealed by the survey was for a compulsory physical examination for all members of the College staff to be given by the College health service. More handball courts and regular periods for faculty use were also requested.

Many felt that the School of Physical Education and Athletics should introduce and supervise an intramural program, including golf, horseshoes, volleyball, mullball, handball, and tennis. Competition would be among the staffs of the various Schools of the College.

LEWIS APPOINTED HEAD OF LIBRARY COMMITTEE

Willard P. Lewis, College librarian, was named chairman of a State-wide committee to establish standards for public library service and certification of librarians at a meeting of a State-wide committee on library service which met at Harrisburg last week.

The program of the committee will consist of library extension survey which will ultimately provide better facilities for extension and correspondence courses for students of the College, the librarian stated.

Meeting to study a program of extension work, the committee discussed library extension for rural districts, standards for public libraries, development of school and county libraries, and library service for college and university extension students.
