

### EXAMINATION SCHEDULE

Final examinations for the first semester will be held from Monday, January 29, to Saturday, February 3, inclusive. The designation SEE LIST indicates that the rooms for examinations will be announced or posted by the instructors or departments concerned.

Any student having two examinations scheduled at the same time or three examinations on the same day is required to report the fact in person at the office of the Registrar on the special form provided there. Seniors graduating at mid-year commencement who have examinations scheduled after Wednesday, January 31st, should report that fact on the conflict card in order that they may be scheduled for an earlier regular conflict examination, if possible. To receive adjustments, all conflicts must be reported not later than 5 p. m. Friday, January 19th.

Notices of adjustment will be available at the office of the Registrar for those students who filed conflict cards and will be mailed heads of departments on Monday, January 22. Appointment examinations should not be scheduled until after notices of conflict examinations are available. The dates of the appointment examinations will be announced by the instructors concerned. Examinations will be of two hours' duration, beginning at 8, 10:20, and 2 o'clock.

### 2 AWARDED CASH IN PRIZE CONTEST

Dell '27, Buechele '35 Place Eighth, Ninth, Winning \$250 Annuity For Five Years Each

Robert C. Dell '27, Pittsburgh filling station employee, and Andrew C. Buechele '35 placed eighth and ninth, respectively, each winning \$250 a year for five years, in a prize sogan contest recently sponsored by the "American Weekly."

The contest, which closed on October 23, required those competing to send in coupons from the paper containing a description in twelve words or less of the "American Weekly."

More than 500,000 entered the competition, each one submitting four slogans. There were ten prizes in all, the first being a \$1,000 annuity policy for life, which was won with "The Nation's Reading Habit." Dell's slogan was "The Magazine That Truth Made Famous," while Buechele wrote "Concerning Man and His Friend."

According to the latter, he expects to use the money to help him finish school this year and next and to follow this with some graduate study. Dell said that he plans to use his prize money to pay off his bills.

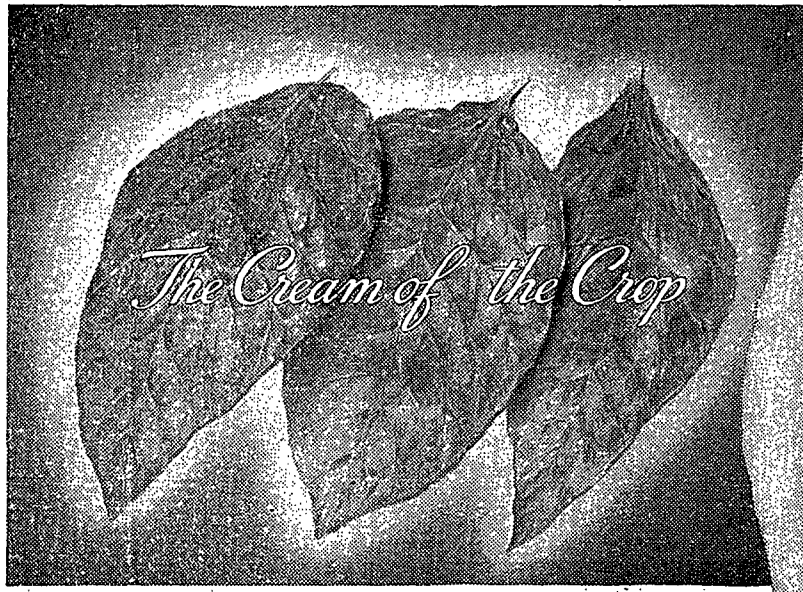
