**CINEMANIA**

Following the presentation of "Petrified Forest" at the Cathaum today, "My Marriage," starring Claire Trevor and Kent Taylor will be presented by that theater tomorrow. A society story of the news behind the headlines, the picture opens with the murder of Miss Trevor's father and the revelation that he, who had been a social leader, was also a racketeer.

She marries Taylor but the latter's mother, played by Pauline Frederick, separates them. Miss Trevor sets out to learn the identity of her father's murderers and uncovers an amazing scandal which restores her to her husband and to society. Paul Kelley, Helen Wood, and Beryl Mercer are others in the cast.

Another of the ever-popular Charlie Chan mysteries is the offering at the Nittany today and tomorrow. In "Charlie Chan's Secret" Warner Oland again portrays the famous Chinese detective first created by Earl Derr Biggers. At a family spiritualistic seance the missing heir for whom Chan has been searching is suddenly seen. The lights go up and he is discovered dead, with a knife in his back. Chan discovers the manner in which the seance has been planned, but while doing so another murder is committed and Chan narrowly escapes death. In the final scene the detective reenacts the crime and the murderer betrays himself.

Unanimously selected as one of the two or three best pictures of the year, "Mutiny on the Bounty" returns here to the Nittany Thursday. Starring in this filmization of the Nordhoff and Hall story are Charles Laughton, Clark Gable, and Franchot Tone.

"King of the Damned," at the Cathaum Thursday is a GB production starring Conrad Veidt, Noah Berry, and Helen Vinson. It tells the dramatic story of a rebellion in the Santa Maria penal colony in the Caribbean. Veidt leads the uprising on the night that Beery is to be executed. Miss

Vinson, who is the governor's daughter, has been attracted by the convict, but the shock of the rebellion kills her father and she sends for aid. Veidt organizes the settlement, but the government guns are trained on the island and thousands of convicts are killed. The heroic action of Beery ends the slaughter and reform is promised as Veidt receives a pardon and sails away with Miss Vinson.

**Dr. Patrick Appointed To Conservation Job**

Dr. Austin L. Patrick, professor of soil technology, has received an appointment as regional conservator of the Soil Conservation Service for New York, Pennsylvania, Maryland, West Virginia, Delaware, New Jersey, and the New England states.

Dr. Patrick's task will be to correlate soil conservation in this state with the conditions followed out in the northeastern states. He will work from his headquarters in Williamsport. Dr. Patrick will also serve as a member of the Pennsylvania soil conservation advisory committee which aids in the service of planning and extending the technical phases of the erosion control board. Dean Ralph L. Watts and Milton S. McDowell, of the School of Agriculture, and John W. Keller, state forester, complete the committee.
