the six weeks of their stay, and talk only French.  
The students live together in the dormitory quadrangle, which becomes a Parisian village. From seven in the morning until all hours of the night, only French is heard in the northwestern section of the campus. Even in recreational activities, the

students speak French to each other. Both faculty and students dine together.  
In the evenings, there are entertainments put on by the village talent. Dramatics, readings, and songs are featured.  
This method of teaching French is thought to be most practical and effective by many prominent educators in romance languages. Professor Ernst has said, "I'm convinced that in six weeks, a student who has had no experience in speaking will develop more here than in three months in France."

Fifty-seven colleges and universities have adopted as a textbook "Essentials of Physiological Chemistry" written by Dr. Arthur K. Anderson, professor of that subject at the Pennsylvania State College.
