Warnock used the figure of a puritan walking down the road with a Bible under one arm and a gun in the other as exemplifying his viewpoint. He said that idealism—desire for peace—must be tempered with realism. While desiring peace, he said, we must not be blind to danger. "An armed truce, such as exists today in Italy, is very bad," the Dean maintained, "but the pacifists in striving towards peace, assume the goal is already won." Practically the Dean desired to limit arms to a defense of this country and its policies.
