Then midway in the second half, after a 25-yard peg from Murphy to Little had placed the ball in scoring position, Little whipped a 20-yard forward to Ned King for the final score.

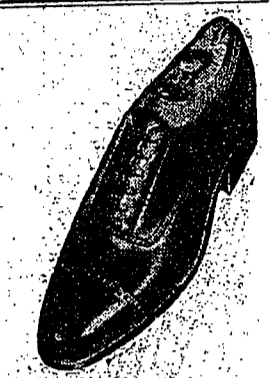
Dr. Palmer C. Weaver, assistant director of the summer session, is attending the meeting of the National Association of deans and directors of
