 the entrance and to the right, will have the schedule cards, white for undergraduates, green for graduate students, and yellow for unclassified.
 After filling out the preliminary schedule cards, summer school students should present them at their respective tables. Unclassified students are to present their cards at tables 5SS and 6SS which are on the far right hand side of the floor.
 Receive Complete Forms
 At table 8A, advance registrants and regular students will receive their complete registration forms, and for those advance registrants who have received no matriculation card, will receive one at this table. For the unclassified summer session students, complete forms will be obtained at table 8B, which is at the southwestern part of the floor.
 After filling in the complete registration blanks, at Section 9 in the center of the building, they are to be taken to table 10 where they will be checked. Final checking will be made at Section 11 on the south side of the building.
 Dormitory keys may be obtained at room 207, Old Main.

International Group Meetings in Session

Penn State will play host to the Institute of International Relations for the Middle Atlantic area June 21 to July 1. The institute has been arranged by the American Friends Service committee in cooperation with the Council for Social Action of the Congregational Church.
 The present world situation, economic foundations of world life, and ethics and religion as applied to world affairs are a few of the courses under study. The theme of the whole course is "Policies Essential to World Peace." Opportunities for critical studies of current world problems and their peaceful solutions will be offered.
 Dr. Ernest M. Patterson, president of the American Academy of Political and Social Science and professor of economics at the University of Pennsylvania, heads the faculty.
