

Women, Beer Outlawed By Rushing Code

Women and beer—they're both taboo as far as the committee supervising the fraternity rushing season here is concerned.

For included in the new code

adopted this year by the Interfraternity Council are provisions specifically barring the utilization of women or beer-distributing establishments during the conduct of the rushing season.

No Girls in Houses
"No girls shall be used in rushing at any time or in any manner," says Section 1, Article IV, of the code. "This also means that girls may not be present in fraternity houses during the time when freshmen by the provisions of this code are permitted to be in the fraternity houses."

And, adds Section 2, "No rushing may be conducted in any beer distributing establishments."

Fraternities also will be limited to two engagements with each rusher. An engagement is defined as breakfast, luncheon, dinner, cake or swimming party.

Alleged violations of the code will be heard and disposed of by a three-man committee comprised of faculty members not affiliated with fraternities which have chapters here. Each member will be compensated a maximum of \$15 for services.

Mandatory penalty for a violation is the postponement of pledging for one day, with the final silent period ending Tuesday night instead of Monday night.

Legion Drum, Bugle Corps Holds Title

A state champion for three consecutive years. That's the record to date of the crack Junior Drum and Bugle Corps of the American Legion's Nittany Post of State College which has gained a large following among students on the campus.

The Corps capped the State championship at Scranton on August 20 and a week later gave their prize-winning minute musical show before 35,000 spectators at the Canadian National Exhibition at Toronto, Canada.

Because of the corps' unusual and brilliant showing, its 14-year-old drum major, Rachel Fulton, was selected to lead the annual Exposition parade comprising of more than 20,000 marchers.

The Corps connection with the campus is close. Its manager, C. W. Buckley Taylor, is a Penn State graduate. Its music coach for the

last year was Albert P. Lyford '28, president of last year's Blue Band, while its inspection officer is Second Lieutenant J. H. Weske, of the ROTC department. The new music coach this year will be another State student, majoring in music.

(Continued From Page One) students carrying at least three-fourths of the normal schedule. **AGE** The Student Aid Program is limited to young people between the ages of 16 and 24 inclusive. Students shall have reached their 16th birthday before they can be assigned to Student Aid. Students who have reached their 25th birthday are ineligible.

function and responsibility of the officials of the institution.

Student Aid Application and Certification of Need Each student or prospective student desiring assistance under the program shall make application for acceptance on **STUDENT APPLICATION—COLLEGE AND GRADUATE AID, NYA Form 21**. Applications approved by the institution must be properly endorsed and submitted to the State Youth Director before transmittal of the first time report of the school year for College and Graduate Aid Application, the approving officer shall be the president of the college or his designated representative.
