And, adds Section 2, "No rushing may be conducted in any beer dis-tributing establishments."

Fraterinties also will be limited to two engagements with each tushee An engagement is defined as breakfast, luncheon, dinne, calib or swimming party.

Alleged violations of the code will be heard and disposed of by a three nan committee comprised of faculty members not affiliated with fraterinties which have chapters here, Each member will be compensated a maximum of \$15 for services.

Mandatory penalty for a violation is the postponement of pledging for one day, with the final select period ending Tuezday right instead of Monday night.


