Construction under outright \$1,576,094 grant)
Remodelling of Carnegie Library to provide 36 classrooms and 14 offices

- 2—Addition of south wing to Mechanical Laboratory
- 3—Completion of Botany Building (Buchhout Laboratory) with central and east units
- 4—Addition of south wing to Main Engineering Building.
- 5—Addition of south wing to Recreation Hall, containing new locker rooms, showers and swimming pool
- 6—Construction of barn and crop storage facilities and necessary

sheds in a central location on the College farms to house farm machinery, including removal of the old gray barns
7—Construction of house breeding barn, completing four units of that type on the campus (Other three are the dairy, sheep, and beef cattle barns)
8—Construction of swine barn and unit to dairy barn to replace the temporary sheds now in use
9—Construction of greenhouse for botany study and headhouses for horticulture work
10—Addition of east wing to new library, (originally planned but later scrapped)

PART II
1—Construction of new women's dormitory, housing 425 girls, between Gange Dormitory and White Hall (new women's activities building)
2—Construction of four men's dormitories, housing 500 men, in quadrangular style, stretching south toward Mineral Industries Building from Irvin, Watts and Jordan (formerly Freat) Halls
3—Addition of east wing to infirmary
4—Provision for additional boiler and power house space to provide heat and power necessary for the expanded College plant

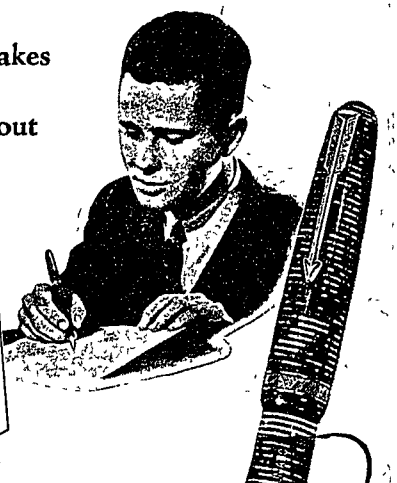
