



souls is still a universal object of discrimination and persecution in the deep South they are segregated in schools that are woefully inadequate by every national criterion. They are denied the most elementary civil liberties. They are virtually excluded from anything like remunerative employment all the way from the liberal professions to the most menial occupations. They are made social patriots in a world that is fiercely intolerant of all minorities and from which there is no escape.

The Challenge at Home

These and similar domestic problems constitute a much more serious challenge to the future of American democracy than all the foreign "isms" that peculiarly awaken our crusading ardor. We have been taught to regard democracy as "a form of government in which supreme power is lodged in the hands of the people collectively." But has it not become something vastly more comprehensive today? In an age when wealth denotes privilege and when the forces of law are made the bulwark of an inequitable social and economic system is it not necessary to broaden our concept of the function and aims of modern democracy?

Above all, we must give a new reality and a wider validity to our traditional political ideals. We need not recall the tragedy of Spain in order to realize that our liberties are always in danger and that constant vigilance is the price we must pay for their preservation. And the place to begin reform is at home!
