

Dr. Mack Heads Textile Research

From high school science teacher Pauline Beery Mack progressed to director of research in home economics and professor of textile chemistry, editor of Science Text, and one of the country's leading authorities on textile industry.

Recognized as one of the nation's foremost consultants on textiles, she is much in demand both as a researchist and as a speaker on popular science.

To her fellow workers she has brought the benefits of new sci-

fic discoveries through the publication of her leaflets. To the layman she has imparted her findings in "Chemistry Applied to Home and Community" and "Stuff, the Story of Materials in the Service of Man."

Born in Norborne, Mo. in 1891, Pauline Beery was graduated with Bachelor of Arts degree from the Missouri State University in 1913. She taught science in two Missouri high schools for five years and in 1918 became head of the science department at Springfield high school.

In addition to her work there she found time to earn her Master of Arts degree from Columbia University in 1919. The same year she came here she began her rise through assistant and associate professorships to her present position.

She is a member of Phi Beta Kappa, Sigma Xi, Iota Sigma Pi, Omicron Nu, Sigma Delta Epsilon, and the American Home Economics Association.

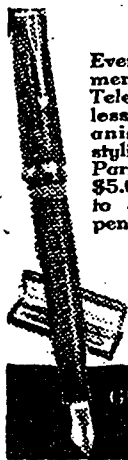

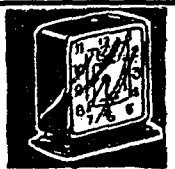
