Seen' ez how I instigated this practice, I gess there is no one bettah kwaleefied to give yo the dope on jest ho wto ketch the man o' yo dreams.

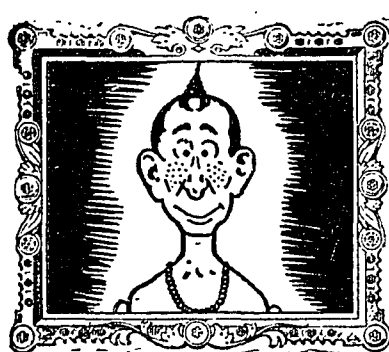
