### Drydock May Have Special Yule Program

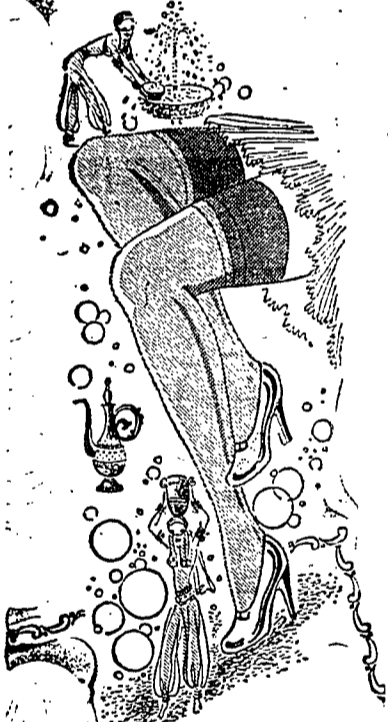
Drydock night club is making tentative plans to follow last year's precedent in presenting a special Christmas program, probably Saturday night, December 4.

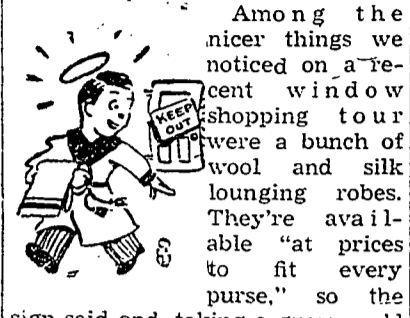

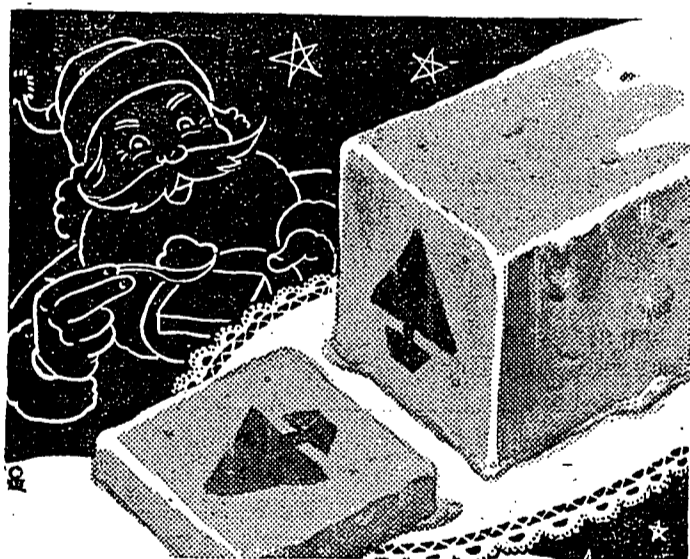
Besides the monetary admission price, which has not as yet been set, cans of vegetables or fruit will be required for admittance. These will be donated to the Local

The monetary profit will be turned over to the Student Welfare Committee, headed by Mrs. Hetzel, which provides loans for needy students.

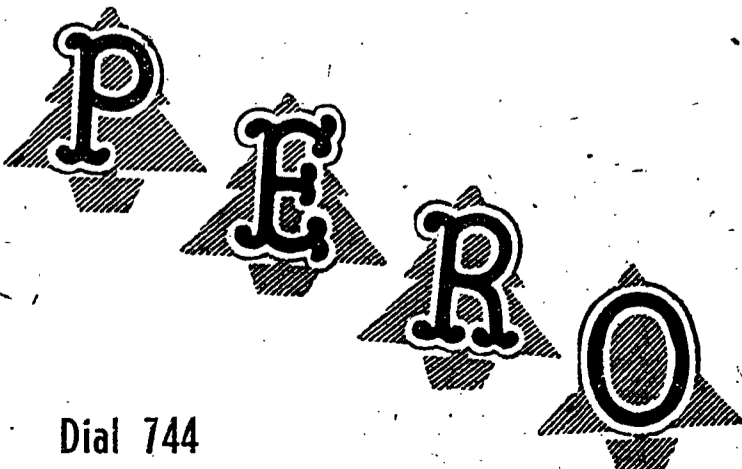
Thomas C. Backenstose '41, president of Skull and Bones, is chairman of the dance committee. He will be assisted by the presidents of the other hat societies.
