Grapplers Seek To Upset Lehigh In Bouts Here At 8 Tomorrow

Lehigh Matmen To Risk Long Winning Streak

In what is highlighted as probably the toughest wrestling scrap of the year, the Nittany Lion grapplers will take to the mats against a favored Lehigh squad in Rec Hall at 8 p.m. tomorrow in an attempt to wrest away an Engineer 17-match winning streak.

Coach Charlie Speidel is counting on Veterans Captain Frank Gleason, Joe Scalzo, and Chuck Rohrer to steal the thunder away from the Lehigh mathematicians and send them home minus a victory.

Close duels are expected between Captain Frank Gleason and 136-pound Albert Lee, and Lehigh's Captain Frank Bailey, who has been undefeated this year, and 128-pound Charley Ridenour. Chuck Rohrer, Nittany 165-pounder, is facing Art Bryne, a strong, undefeated sophomore.

Cagers To Battle Owls Tomorrow

A hapless bunch of Nittany cagers, disappointed after their unexpected loss to West Virginia, will travel to Philadelphia tomorrow where they meet an old foe, Temple, in Convention Hall.

The Owls have one of their best teams in a long time this year and will be odds-on favorites over the Lions. The No. 1 feather in Temple's cap is a 42-38 victory over Rhode Island State, considered the top team in the East. The Philadelphians also hold a one-point win over Georgetown.

For State, Coach John Lawther will undoubtedly start the same five that opened against the Mountaineers. This will put Captain John Barr and Elmer Gross at forwards, Herk Baltimore at center, and Dick Grimes and Bob Ramin at the guards.

Four Freshman Squads In Competition Tomorrow

Freshman wrestling and swimming teams open their season tomorrow and two more yearling squads, victorious in their last meets, are primed for competition in gymnastics and basketball.

Penn State and Lehigh first-year men will stage their initial grappling match for this season in Rec Hall while the Little Lion swimmers compete at Mercersburg. The freshman basketballers who downed Bucknell, 42-31, Wednesday evening will attempt a win over Wyoming Seminary tomorrow. Having beaten Temple 34-40 last week, the yearling gymnasts are ready to compete at Navy.

Elated Lion Gymnasts Meet Strong Army Team Away Tomorrow

An inspired squad of Lion gymnasts, elated with their upset victory over Navy's Eastern championship team last Saturday, will tackle an even tougher opponent tomorrow afternoon when it meets a strong Army outfit at West Point.

Lion Fencers Oppose Navy Here Tomorrow


