To Teach at Brown

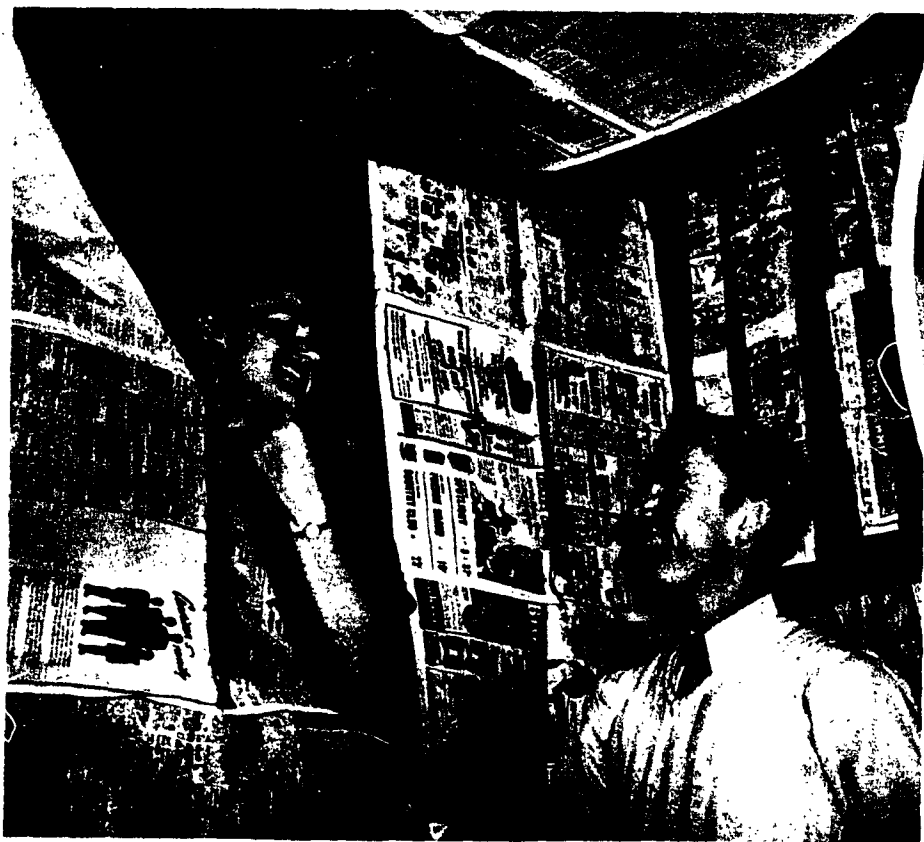
When the French steamer St. Dominique docked at Staten Island recently, on board was Charles Beyer, an Alsatian, who will teach French at Brown University.
