

Service Board To Aid With Point System

Sophomores, Juniors To Fill Out Cards

Sophomore and junior women living in northeast Atherton will fill out point system cards in the northeast lounge at 10 p. m. tomorrow, under WSGA Junior Service Board supervision.

Sophomore and junior women will list officer and membership points for this year only. Senior women will be eliminated and freshmen will fill out cards next semester.

Each coed is allowed 40 points but her officer points must not exceed 32. Value for officer points, subject to WSGA change, is as follows: 28 points—WSGA president; 24 points—women's editor of Collegian, Froth business manager, PSCA president, WRA president, WRA treasurer; 20 points—Co-Edition editor, women's feature editor of Collegian, Collegian junior editorial board, PSCA vice-president, WRA publicity chairman, WSGA vice-president, and WSGA sophomore senator.

Officers rating 16 points are Co-Edition business manager, Collegian editorial candidates, Collegian junior business board, Panhellenic Council president, PSCA secretary, Penn State Players' president, WRA club activities chairman, WSGA secretary, WSGA treasurer, WSGA senior and junior senators.

Twelve points are given to Co-Edition circulation manager, Collegian women's sports editor, Collegian senior secretary candidates, fraternity presidents, Froth junior editorial staff, Froth sophomore editorial staff, Froth freshman board, Judicial chairman, La Vie managing editor, La Vie photo editor, Mortar Board president, Omicron Nu president, Philotes president, Student Handbook co-editor, Student Handbook assistant business manager, Thespian manager, prop girl and costume girl, WRA vice-president, WSGA freshman and town senator.

Deserving 8 points are Co-Edition junior and senior staff members, Ellen H. Richards president, 4-H Club president, Fraternity treasurers, fraternity rushing chairmen, fraternity pledge mistresses, Froth advertising, circulation and assistant business man-

ager, Home Economics Club president, Home Economics Club treasurer, Junior Service Board members, La Vie junior candidates, La Vie junior board, Omicron Nu vice-president, Panhellenic vice-president, PSCA treasurer, PSCA commissions chairman, Penn State Players secretary, Pi Lambda Theta president, Portfolio editor and managing editor, school councils president, WRA club presidents, WRA club secretaries, WSGA freshman council secretary.
