

Ewell To Compete In Summer Meets

Having climaxed a glorious college track career with his triple win in the Intercollegiate in New York last weekend, Penn State's outstanding running star, Barney Ewell, will continue through the Summer in competition in exhibition meets throughout the country.

The first of these meets in which he will take part is a special exhibition in Rochester, N. Y., next weekend. He expects to enter the nation's armed forces near the end of this month. Before that time he will compete in the NCAA and the National AAU meets.

Running unattached, he will try to add to the glory he has already won for himself and his school in these meets against the cream of the nation's track crop. He will probably wear the Nittany Blue and White into these battles before he takes on the khaki of the United States Army.

The Lion team, travelling without the presence of its brilliant leader, will carry out its part in the Summer sports program in its only meet of the Summer, a four-

team affair in the Cornell stadium July 4 to benefit Army-Navy relief. Events for this meet will be 120-yard high hurdles, 440-yard run, 880-yard run, mile run, 880-yard relay, and a special 600-yard run.

Baseball Lions Beat Pitt, 12-6, Prepare To Start New Season

Diamondmen Record 8 Wins; 6 Losses

Turning in their second win of the season over Pittsburgh here Memorial Day before the largest crowd of the year, Penn State's baseball Lions wound up their Spring season with a record of eight victories and six losses.

Unless Coach Joe Bedenk's minions play several warm-up games, two contests against Colgate University on the Hamilton, N. Y., diamond June 19 and 20, will mark the start of the Summer season. However, the Blue and White will probably meet several service teams.

Sophomores, who two weeks ago were playing with Coach Leo Houck's freshman nine, will make their appearance in the lineup as the next official intercollegiate season gets under way. At the same time, all seniors, or players who have played three seasons with the varsity, will be ineligible.

Two of the matches recorded on the winning side of the books were registered over Pitt. The second game, which ended 12-6 in State's favor, was registered Saturday. Navy Relief benefitted from the fray.
