Article VI: Org
chool Councils shall hold elections in the manner prescribed by the respective councils. All School Council elections shall be subject to the approval of the elections committee.
Article VII: Organization of Addi-
tional Cliques
Any group may form itself into a political clique providing it folzation in Article VI of this code and other regulations set forth. A group desiring to organize into a political clique must arrive at a name and specify that name to the chairman of Elections Committee at least two days prior to be turned in. The group must submit the membership list by $4 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{m}$. July 11.
A clique must have an official clique chairman and secretary. In order to submit candidates for general elections the clique must submit candidates for at least a
majority of the semesters involved in that particular' election. One in that particular election. One clique may not organize as a temfor less than a majority of the semesters involved in the electioon.

## Article VIII: Methods of Cam-

 paigningAn amount t"not exceeding $\$ 15$ may be spent by each clique for
publicity purposes (purchase of publicity purposes (purchase of
signs, handbills, cards, etc.). Cliques shall dispense with public address systems for campaigning purposes.
The fund designated for publicity purposes shall be collected by the clique and will not be all cated from any $\$ 5$ fund
to each clique by the Elections Committee to compensate for the former use of printed Elections Committee posters. This $\$ 5$ must be used to cover the cost of printed posters and the cost of purchasing additional photographs or prints. the Elections Committee for use at the polls.
$\therefore$ The committee will meet with candidates and clique chairmen at ${ }^{4}$ p.m. Monday, July 17, in Old Main to answer any questions, clarify the elections code, or hear any complaints of code violations. The committee will meet again men after the closing of the polls and before the counting of votes, July 19, in Old Main when further complaints will be heard. Only clique chairmen and Elections Committee members may witness the vote counting.

Article X: Eligibility to Vote An official voting registration will take place at the college reg-
:stration (June 30 and July 1). Each istration shane fill out a form which will be filed by the-Elections Committee and used to check off each voter. This registration list shal je official together with the regis trar's records. Any student regis-
tering late or who for other reatering late or who for other rea-
sons has not filled out an official registration card must withhold is vote until his name and semester rank have been checked in the :egistrar's office by a member of :he Elections Committee. The stu dent if found eligible to vote will then fill out his registration card at the polls, signed by a men
of the Elections Committee. Only undergraduate stud will be eligible to vote. i.e., those students" who pay their own fees All students must present some means of identification at the polls before being permitted to cast his jallot.
Article XI: Party Affiliations Party affiliations of every can-
didate will be placed upon the bal lots. It is necessary for every canlots. It is necessary for every can-
didate to have a party affiliation. Typed lists of all voters will be ziven to the clique chairman or secretary, providing neither of these officers is a candidate for semester office. If one or both officers are candidatees a member of the clique will be given the list of voters upon presentation of a note rom the clique chairman to tee stating he is a clique member This list will be prepared every hour during the two day voting

## period.

Article XII: Violations
