Choir, Orchestra To Hold Tryouts
 Prof. Fishburn Urges Students to Compete

Freshmen, transfer students, upperclassmen, and graduate students are urged by Prof. Hummel Fishburn, head of the music department, to compete for places in the College Choir, Blue Band, and College Symphony Orchestra. Choir, a one credit class, rehearses in 117 Carnegie Hall each Thursday night from 7 to 9 p.m. and furnishes the music for the Chapel service each Sunday morning. Tenors and basses are especially needed in the group and a few sopranos and altos can be accepted.

Tryouts for men's Choir positions will be held Monday from 7 to 9 p.m. Women will be heard Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday between 4 and 5 p.m. Appointments for auditions can be made by calling 216 Carnegie Hall today between 8 and 5 o'clock.

Woodwind, brass, and percussion applicants for Blue Band or Symphony Orchestra will be heard in 117 Carnegie Hall starting at 7 p.m. Wednesday. Prof. Fishburn, conductor of both groups stated that he wishes to hear both old members and new applicants at that time. Students who do not own instruments may tryout on those belonging to the College.

Many new members are needed to supplement the Symphony Orchestra, a one credit course, to bring its personnel to the normal number of 75 performers stated Prof. Fishburn. Stringed instrument players may audition in 117 Carnegie Hall starting at 7 p.m. Monday. Woodwind, brass, and percussion players will be heard at the same time as students trying out for Blue Band.
