Dr. Wise is rabbi of the Free Synagogue, New York, president of the Jewish Institute of Religion and president of the American and the World Jewish Congresses. Born in Budapest, Dr. Wise has

been active in Jewish life in the German speaking lands of Europe He was one of the founders of the Zionist movement, and was found er of the Zionist Organization of America in 1898. He served as president of this organization from 1936 to 1938 and was its represen ative at the Versailles Peace conerence. He also served as chairnan of the United Palestine Ap-

The Rabbi has been active in eligious, educational, and civic vork in the city of New York and hroughout the country. He was me of the founders of the Amercan Jewish Congress and the Jew sh Institute of Religion school for he training of men for the Jew sh ministry and for leadership in ne field of education and social

A graduate of Columbia Univer ity, Dr. Wise has received numer f "Opinion," a monthly journal of ewish life and letters, and the uthor of several books.


