

Day of Atonement Begins With Kol Nidre Services

Services in observance of Yom Kippur (Day of Atonement) will be conducted at the Hillel Foundation, 133 West Beaver avenue, from sundown today to sunset tomorrow, it was announced by Rabbi Benjamin M. Kahn, Director of the Foundation. The Day of Atonement, the most solemn day in the Jewish year, is a day of confession of sins, fasting and repentance.

The services on Friday evening will begin with the Kol Nidre

prayer for absolution of vows between man and God which a person may have been unable to fulfill during the year. There will be two Kol Nidre services at the Foundation. The first will begin at 6 p.m. for sophomores and juniors; the second at 8:15 p.m. for seniors, graduate students, faculty, and townspeople.

Services Saturday will begin at 9 a.m. and will continue until sunset. Rabbi Kahn will officiate and deliver the sermons.
