

Riflewomen Retain Runner-up Spot DG's Hold Musical For Blind

Penn State riflewomen placed second in their two opening inter-collegiate matches, according to telegraphic returns, Wanda Rickard, Rifle Club president, said today.

The College team forfeited first place to Beaver College by one point, 492-491, in the initial match. University of Nevada took third place and University of Wisconsin fourth, shooting 485 and 479 respectively. Scores represent the five highest out of ten targets shot by each college.

College Shoots 497

Penn State shot 497 out of a possible 500 in the second match, Miss Rickard and Laura Wiley shooting perfect targets. Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical College shot 500 for first place. Drexel Institute took third place with 493, Ohio University placing fourth with 479.

Shooting in the opening meet were Jean Heath and Barbara Knoll, 99; Levetta Dinius and Wanda Rickard, 98; Marion Johnson, 97. In the second match, besides Miss Rickard and Miss Wiley's perfect targets, Nancy Killam, Barbara Knoll, and Laurie Zekauskas shot 99.

Also shooting in the first match but not included in intercollegiate

scoring were Laurie Zekauskas, Laura Wiley, Lois Wyman, and Jean Posey, 97; Nancy Killam, 95. In the second meet, besides the five already mentioned, were Jean Posey, 99; Joan Heath, 98; Polly Goodwin, Joanne Houtz, and Betty Jean Sammens, 97.

The varsity will face University of Kansas, University of Michigan, and the University of Hawaii Friday.

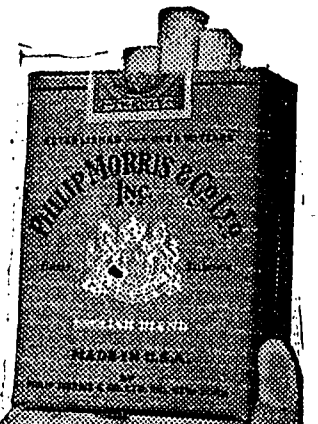
