

Women's Telegraphic Swim Team Breaks 3 Records

The women's telegraphic swimming team this week broke all three first place records set by Penn State in the intercollegiate last year.

Lee Ann Wagner, swimming the 40-yard crawl in 22.3 seconds, broke last year's 22.4 record set by Hannie Ludwig. The 75-yard relay time of 46.5 seconds which took first place in the nationals last year for the College was broken by Ruth Black, Judy Klein and Lee Ann Wagner, clocking 45.4 seconds.

The third national record won by Penn State mermaids last year, the 100-yard freestyle relay set at 57.75 seconds, was chipped to 55.3 by Ruth Black, Judy Klein, Lee

Ann Wagner and Jacqueline Zivic. None of the women in this relay swam on last year's winning team, which was composed of Pauline Globisch, Louise Lowe, Hannie Ludwig and Lois Wyman.

National Rating Saturday
Swimming the events Thursday and Monday nights for the College, the varsity did not know their national rating until after Saturday, when the clockings are officially due. Last year's team placed first in the region and took national second place.

Lee Ann Wagner, who figured in all three new records, and Judy Klein both were swimming telegraphics for the first time for the College. Mrs. Klein, Mrs. Robert Klein in Windcrest circles, is a transfer student from University of Pennsylvania where she took numerous records.

Also slated as a hope for national placement by Miss Marian Whallon, swim club advisor, was Judy Klein's 53-second timing in the 75-yard individual relay. Marilyn Globisch took regional first and national fifth places in that event last year with 58 seconds. Ruth Black also lowered the Globisch time, swimming the relay in 57.2 seconds.

Mrs. Klein topped the 1 minute 22.1 second timing which took fourth national for State last year, clocking in at 1 minute 18.3 seconds. Miss Black swam the 40-yard back crawl in 27.5 seconds, topping the 28.4-second time which took a tie for third national last year.

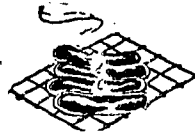
