

Stark Leads Bedenkmen In Batting Averages; Four Hit Over .300

Coach Joe Bedenk's 150-pound outfield "find," Don Stark, belted the ball at a .362 clip in his first season of college baseball competition.

Another left-hander, Hal Hackman, came home second with a .326 average, followed by Ken Yount, pitching star, with a .314 batting average.

The next two places also went to pitchers—the captain-elect, Bob Gehrett and Bill Benyish. Like Stark and Hackman, Gehrett and Benyish both hit from the left side.

Dave Pincus took sixth in the junior discus throw with a toss of 138 feet, 7 inches, and failed to place in the senior competition with a throw of 135 feet, 8 inches.

Karver, in addition to his triple win, also holds the distinction of running the fastest college mile since 1941, the IC-4A indoor mile and the Coliseum relay mile.

Stone holds the National AAU indoor three-mile title, the IC-4A indoor two mile title, two IC-4A outdoor two-mile titles and the Penn State, Franklin Field and IC-4A outdoor record of 9:11.8 for two miles.

Ewell's time of 21 seconds flat in the 200 was only one-tenth off the AAU record set in 1937.

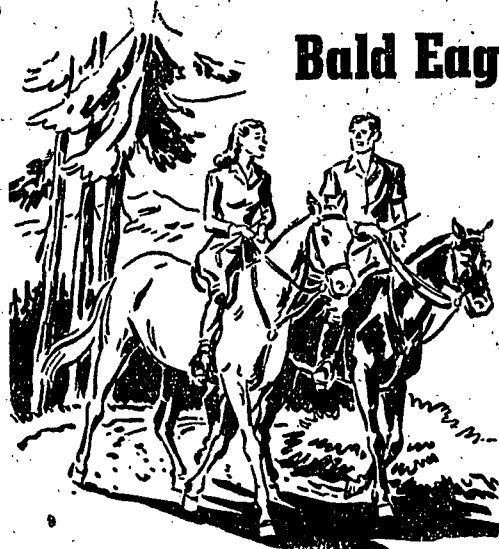
