Desperate long shot attempts by the Bisons in the waning minutes failed to connect and the Scot's booters left the turf with their first victory of the season firmly in hand.

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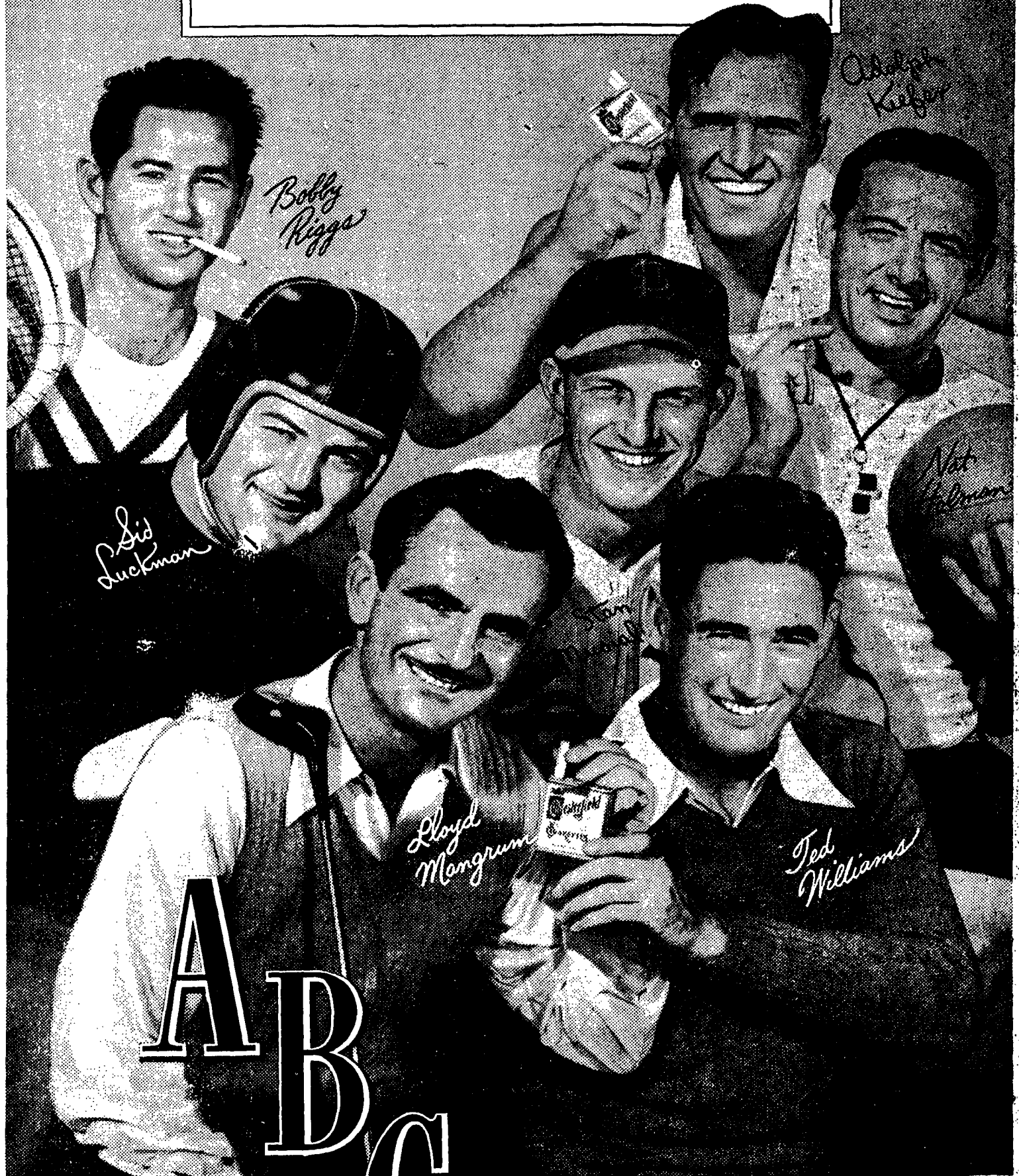
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
