WSGA Senate voted to accept the suggestion of the Coed Coordinating Committee that the "blanket permission" coed excuse forms be issued in triplicate sheets.

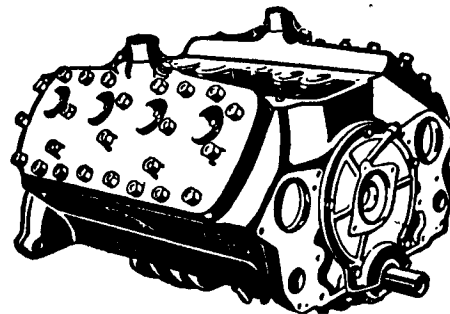
In this method, one form will be sent to the parents, one kept by the dormitory hostess and the other signed by the parents and filed in the Dean of Women's office. It was decided that whenever a coed uses her permission, a post card will be sent by the

dormitory hostess to notify her parents that she has done so.

The Coed Coordinating Committee and Miss Edith Zinn, assistant to the dean of women, have completed surveys taken of colleges and universities comparable to the College to see if they have "blanket permissions" and by what method they carry it out. Of the 22 colleges who responded 16 are successfully using the "blanket permission" method.
