

# Princeton Dean Speaks in Chapel

"Students in the World Crisis" will be Henry Pitt VanDusen's topic at Chapel services in Schwab auditorium at 11 o'clock tomorrow morning.

Dr. VanDusen, who has been Dean of Students at Princeton since 1932, received his doctorate at the University of Edinburgh after studying at Union Theological Seminary.

Author of "In Quest of Life's Meaning," Dr. VanDusen is a member of the staff of Union Theological Seminary, New York City. A graduate of Princeton University, Dr. VanDusen is a member of Phi Beta Kappa, a member of the Board of Managers of the Intercollegiate branch of YMCA, a fellow of the National Council on Religion in Higher Education, and a member of the Board of Governors of the Princeton Summer Camp.

Dr. VanDusen, valedictorian and ivy orator during his Princeton days, is editor and contributor to "The Church Through Half a Century," and "Ventures in Relief." He was also a debater, and later debating team captain, during his college days.

# A message to you from the Chief of Staff



"April 6 is Army Day. It is a day which will have a special meaning for college men. More than half of you are veterans of the last war. Many of you are members of the Organized Reserve. Many others belong to the R.O.T.C. or National Guard.

"All of you are making a vital contribution toward World Peace and the security of this nation.

"The U. S. Army is the finest army in the world and the only one of its kind among the major powers. It is 100% volunteer. "Further, I know the valuable service you can render the nation in time of emergency. A great deal of the success of fast mobilization and the actual winning of the war was due to the 106,000 trained Reserve Officers and the top-notch National Guard units which were available for quick action.

"To you, on Army Day, I believe I speak for millions of Americans in offering commendation for the fine job you are doing."
