

Do Yogis Select Blindfolded?

A host of grid upsets made the Collegian yogis' selections look like the work of a blindfolded boy sticking pins in a chart this week.

All four of the football "experts" percentages dropped below .700 for the first time this season. Red (not so hopeless now) Roth, predicting two upset winners, Pitt and Alabama, successfully, led the selectors this week by picking eight right and four on the other side of the ledger.

Sports editor Tom (between the lions) Morgan, Elliot (lucky) Krane, and George (unlucky) Vadasz, all had seven correct and five wrong. Krane and Vadasz continue to lead the prognosticating derby with percentages of .894, Morgan has a forecasting average of .877, and Roth still trails the pack with a .627 percentage.

Grid Throng Breaks Mark

The 14-14 stalemate between the Nittany Lion and Michigan State football teams Saturday was played before an all-time home high of 24,000 fans. Harold R. Gilbert, graduate manager of athletics, said yesterday.

Previous high for the College was 23,000, set in 1923 when "Lighthorse" Harry Wilson almost single-handedly defeated the Navy, 21-3, on New Beaver field.

Already in three games, Gilbert said, the Lions have attracted 56,000 at home as compared with the previous high of 49,139. Moreover, the Lion team will play before the greatest crowd in Penn State history when 75,000 jam Franklin field, Philadelphia, for the November 6 date with Penn.
