Just in case things get dull, Coach Lawrence can inject into the game another All-American prospect in the guise of Ed Brett, who ranks thirtieth in the nation in point scoring. The 5-foot 11-inch forward to date has posted 80 markers for a 16-point game average. Brett and Vandeweghe co-captain the team.

Other starters for Colgate will be Curt Norris, who scored 203 points last year, to team with Brett at the forwards, and Jerry Palatini and Bob Plunkett at the guard spots. Behind them Lawrence can use Frank Warren.
