

# Panhel Installs Jelacic; Rushing Begins This Weekend

Delores Jelacic was installed as new president of Panhellenic Council by Adelaide Finkelston, resigning president, at a meeting Tuesday night.

Miss Jelacic, a member of Kappa Delta, automatically succeeds to the presidency from her previous position as vice-president. Nancy George of Alpha Xi Delta succeeds to vice-president.

Informal rushing will begin with Open Houses Saturday afternoon.

Rules regulating the Open Houses restrict rushees from staying at one sorority for more than twenty minutes, except in the case of coeds attending the Jewish sorority Open Houses, where they may stay for one hour. No decorations other than on refreshment tables, no favors or invitations may be used for open houses and \$5 is the limit of expenses.

A silent period will be observed from 5 p. m. Sunday to 8 a. m. Monday.

Rushing from this point on is restricted only by a provision of "Dutch Treat" on all coke dates, no planned parties or entertainment, and the stipulation that bids may not be sent by sororities until March 14. Bids must be delivered stamped and unsealed to the dean of women's office.

Only coeds with a one semester transfer grade or a 1.0 All-College average are eligible for rushing and for this reason should report to Miss Ellamae Jackson to have their transcripts averaged.

Sororities were reminded that all pledges should be reported as to date of pledging and complete name to the president of Panhel and the dean of women's office. They should further take the complete name and semester of all girls about to be initiated to the dean of women's office one week before initiation.

## Plans Formulated For May Day Affair

The annual May Day ceremonies will be held on May 7, according to Shurley Gauger, president of the House of Representatives.

The names of the May Queen and her court, elected by the College women, will be announced the previous evening, at the WSGA Coronation Ball held in conjunction with the traditional May Day program. During the course of the dance the Queen and her entourage will be presented.

Miss Gauger stated that attendance at House of Representative meeting is compulsory for all living units and will be strictly enforced.


