

Panhellenic Council Acts To Establish Junior Group

Panhellenic Council at its meeting Tuesday night voted to establish a Junior Panhel after discussing the merits of such an organization as proposed by Dolores Jelacic at a previous meeting.

Central purpose of the junior society is to eventually strengthen Panhel by way of making younger sorority members more conscious of the Council's activities and preparing them to ultimately become better senior members.

Specific considerations of the junior organization would be the learning of Robert's "Rules of Order," helping with rushing ideas and planning social events.

Eliminate Seniors

Panhel hopes eventually to eliminate seniors from the Council and to compose its membership of juniors and sophomores, while membership of Junior Panhel would be freshmen. The vice-president of Panhel will serve as chairman of the junior group.

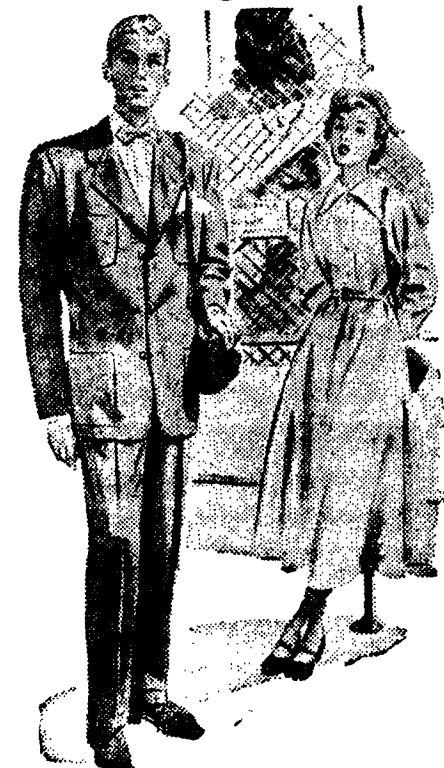
