the fixed nitrogen research laboratory

For the past 28 years he has been with the University of Wisconsin, starting as Assistant Professor from 1920-24, Associate Professor from 1924-28 and Professor since 1928. In addition to teaching physical chemistry Dr. Daniels has engaged in research in chemical kinetics and photochemistry.

During the first World War, Dr. Daniels engaged in research on gas masks, and in World War II he was connected with the Manhattan Project for Atomic Energy. In 1945-46 he served as Director of the Metallurgical Laboratory in Chicago and has been on the board of the Argonne National Laboratory for the past three years.
