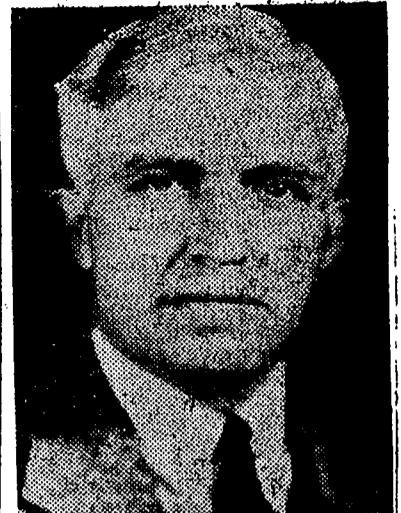
Formidable Nucleus
