Dutch Sykes, assistant IM director, requests that representatives of the Altoona touch football team and the Dorm 2 swimming team call at his office for their schedules.

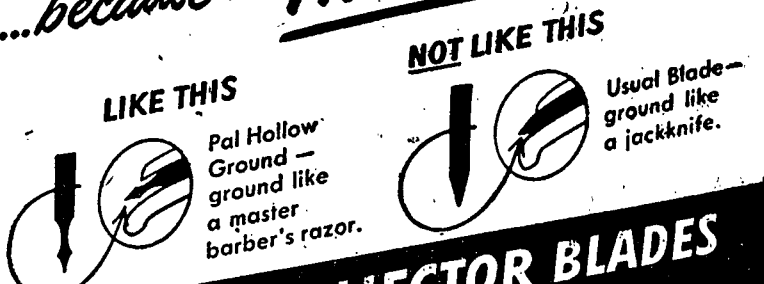
