

Coal Supply Drops As Cold Continues

Cold and coal at the College are continuing in opposite directions.

The weatherman predicts increased cold, with last night being the coldest night of the winter. Recorded temperature at 4 p.m. yesterday was 13 degrees. The College coal supply is still diminishing despite small amounts being purchased.

Supervisor of Utilities, R. Y. Sigworth, said yesterday that the continuing cold weather is causing a greater consumption of coal than ordinarily used at this time of year.

An attempt is being made to reduce the amount of coal burned, without lowering room temperatures excessively. Students are urged to conserve heat by keeping windows closed when rooms are not occupied, and by not allowing drafts to circulate.

The College Meteorology department says the cold spell will continue through the weekend with rising temperatures, followed by possible rain or snow early next week.
