

# NSA to Champion Views Of US Students at Parley

The National Student Association will champion the views of more than 800,000 American students at the World Student Congress to be held this August in Prague, Czechoslovakia, according to an NSA statement.

The congress, sponsored by the communist-dominated International Union of Students, has been accused by the NSA of inviting only a "token" two-or three-man delegation from the United States.

"We will form a full 12-man observer-delegation to attend the Prague Congress," the staff statement declares.

At previous meetings of the IUS, distorted views of the conditions of American campuses and life in the U. S. have been made by unrepresentative American students, NSA observers have reported.

The NSA had protested vigorously allegedly undemocratic action of the IUS in sending the "official" American invitation to the Committee for International Student Cooperation, a memberless group which sprang up after the NSA suspended negotiation for affiliation with IUS following the 1948 Czech coup, the statement adds.

More than 500 students, representing nations in every corner of the world and more than four million students, will attend the congress.

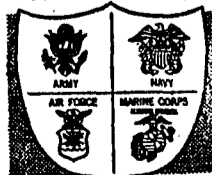
