

Curt Stone Provides Glimpse Into Past

Penn State track fans attending the Blue-White track meet at Beaver Field this Saturday will catch a glimpse of the past when Curt Stone, one of the greatest distance-men in Lion history, puts in an appearance.

But faded Collegians, better than I, can relate the exploits of this Lion great.

November, 1946—Curt Stone out-paced a field of 228 runners representing 36 different colleges to win the IC4-A cross-country crown at New York.

Feb. 25, 1947—Curt Stone surprised Forest Efav in the three mile event at the NAAU games in New York's Madison Square Garden. Stone finished in 14:27.6, twelve yards ahead of the second place winner.

Mar. 4, 1947—Stone, in taking his race, ran the fastest two-mile in Penn State history. His time, 9:17.4, completely outclassed the field of thirty runners, some of whom he lapped six times.

Apr. 29, 1947—Penn Relays—Curt Stone, showing the way to the two-milers at the Relays, clipped eight seconds from the College two-mile standard.

May 13, 1947—Curt Stone, Nittany Lion distance champion, set a new meet (IC4-A) record in the two-mile by running in 9:27.7.

It isn't every day that a Curt Stone visits the Nittany valley or every day that sports fans get an opportunity to see one of the country's top distance men in action—this is the track-fan's chance of a lifetime.

Lacrosse Team Has Toughest Hurdle Sat.

Penn State's lacrosse team will face its toughest competition of the season when the Lion battle the Maryland Lacrosse Club on the golf course tomorrow at 2 p.m. This year, only one ball club has come close in defeating the Maryland team, and that was Mt. Washington. The Marylanders won the game, 6-5.

The win over Mt. Washington is all the more impressive considering that Mt. Washington defeated last year's national collegiate champions, John Hopkins, 6-5. This victory gave Mt. Washington the open-champion title—the winner of the match between the club champion and the collegian titlist.

Outside of the close contest with the open-champs, the Marylanders have been untouchable. They took the University of Delaware into camp, 13-2, as well as

mauling the Annapolis Lacrosse Club, 10-2. Their other two victories were registered via the shutout route—17-0 over College Park and 18-0 over the Philadelphia Lacrosse Club.

Coach Bill Wittelsberger will bring a playing squad of 23 men to face State with the majority of them representing such well-known lacrosse schools as John Hopkins, Maryland, and Loyola of Baltimore.

The starting ten, however, is composed of three players from the University of Maryland and Loyola of Baltimore, two from John Hopkins, and one each from Duke and St. Paul's.

Piorkowski Cops Indie Badminton Title

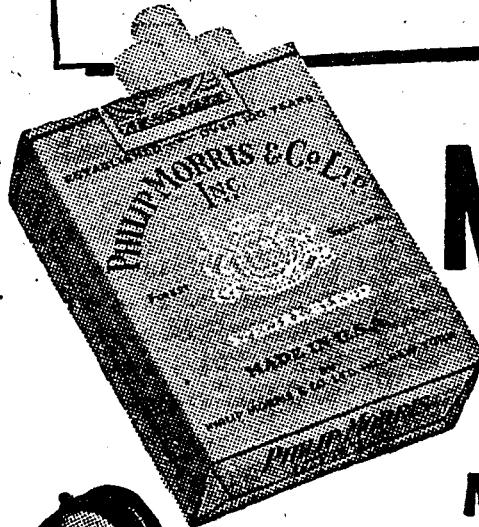
