A livestock judging team from the University of Connecticut spent last Thursday and Friday practice judging the new animals. The group then moved to Cornell University before returning to New Haven, Connecticut.

The livestock, which have gained widespread attention, represent some of the nation's outstanding blood lines in the various breeds of beef cattle, swine, sheep, and horses. This was indi-

cated by Dr. William L. Henning, professor of animal husbandry. Dr. Henning accompanied the visiting group.
