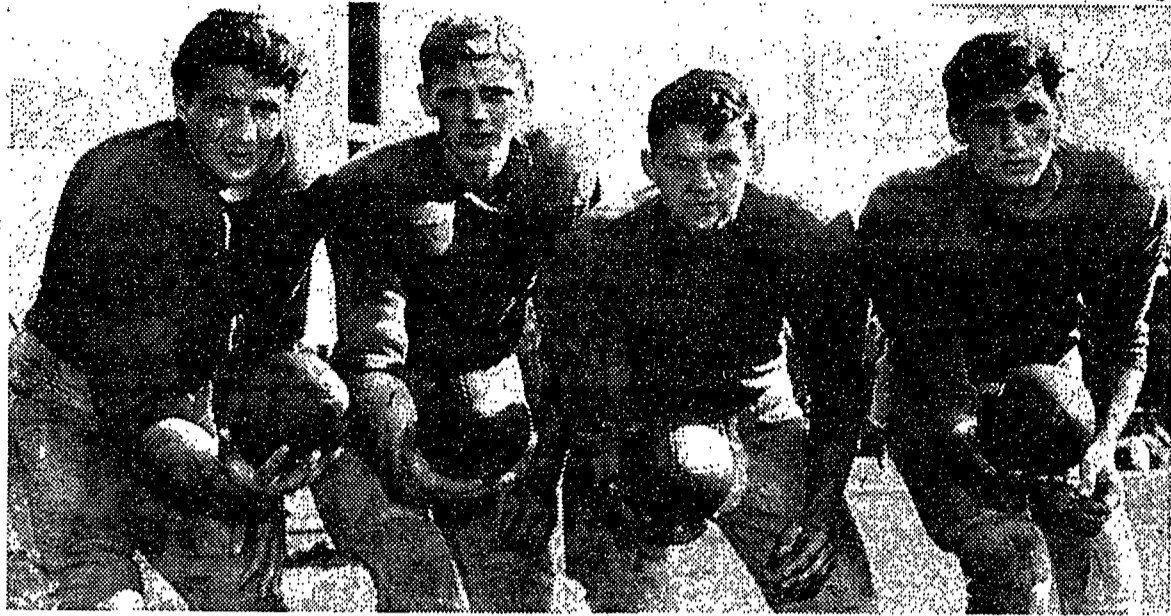


Lion Quarterback Hopefuls

Take 'Athletes' Feet' Seriously

John Lawther, former Military Lion basketball coach and a leading exponent of the zone defense, is now in Mexico teaching Mexican youngsters the American style of play.

On a government-sponsored teaching-coaching tour, Lawther reports that half of the youngsters of high school age refuse to wear shoes when they play.

One oil company in Poza Rica bought hundreds of pairs of shoes but only a few players would wear them.

One boy who walked in every day from the hills to practice insisted that shoes made his feet sore. Meanwhile he was playing on a concrete surface finished very roughly to aid in traction.

Matmen Have Best Athletic Record

Wrestling owns the best all-time record of any intercollegiate sport at the College.

In 41 years of grappling, the Lions have won 193, lost 50 and tied 9 for a 76.5 win percentage.

Under Charlie Speidel, who took over the coaching reins 25 years ago, the Lion wrestlers have won 102, lost 28, tied 7.

Track and cross-country boast a win percentage of 70 to rank behind soccer. Baseball follows with a 68.1 per cent record.
