

Women's Honoraries Orient New Students

Perhaps you've been wondering just who they are—those women on campus wearing little gray hats. They are 42 of the busiest women on campus, members of the women's orientation crew.

Made up of members of Cwens, Chimes, and Mortar Board, sophomore, junior, and senior activity honoraries, the orientation crew, aided by the staff of the Dean of Women's office, is responsible for orienting this year's 1200 new women students to the campus.

The orientation crew began work Sunday by directing new women students to their dormitories, introducing them to their hostesses, and giving them information to guide them during Orientation Week: Sunday night the crew aided hostesses in holding mixers in the various women's dormitories.

Discuss Activities
Beginning Monday night, members of the crew began a series of meetings with individual groups of about 25 new women. Members of the crew discussed campus etiquette and activities at Monday night's meetings, and

answered questions on freshman customs and regulations, penalties, and dormitory rules.

Plan Skits
At last night's meetings, the activities of the Women's Recreation Association were explained. Tonight's meetings will be devoted to discussions of the Women's Student Government Association. Tomorrow night members of the orientation crew will answer questions on Panhellenic Council and Leonides. Meetings for all new women students are being held at 6:45 each night in Schwab Auditorium to explain the functions of these organizations in detail.

intelligently, he said. He emphasized that no Penn State student will be allowed to receive a degree until a proper level of efficiency in communication is reached.

Third on the President's list of values to be had from a proper education was "a basic understanding of all fields of human knowledge."

A fundamental knowledge of all fields of learning is necessary for self-education throughout one's entire life, he said.

College Framework
Judgment and wisdom constituted the fourth value on the President's list.

In college we can learn the

methods leading to a foundation for the wisdom to be gained in maturity, he said. "This knowledge can be used to provide the ethical framework which can lead to the ability to tell the difference between good and bad," he continued.

Last on President Eisenhower's list of values was "a deep and abiding and even fighting commitment to the democratic way of life."

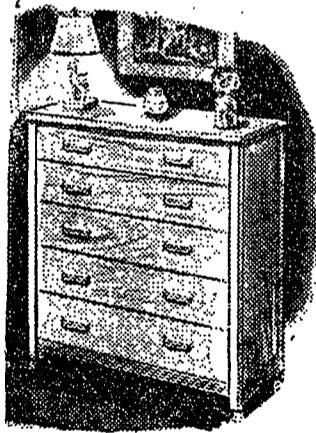
