### Political Parties to Meet

Lion Party members will be asked to approve the first written party constitution in the history of campus politics, while the State Party will continue nominations and hold elections of party clique officers at tonight's meeting.

The State Party will meet at 7 p.m. in 119 Osmond and the Lion Party will meet at the same time in 10 Sparks.

At the last State meeting only three nominations for the available offices were made. Thomas Farrell was nominated for clique chairman, Robert Sherman for senior class vice clique chairman, and Ann Quigley for junior class secretary treasurer.

#### Three to Resign

Nominations of Lion Party officers will not be made until a constitution is approved.

Following the election of the All-College clique officers of the State Party, three of the present four officers will resign. They are Robert Amole, clique chairman; Frank Schrey, vice clique chairman; and Marilyn Minor, secretary. Richard Grossman will continue as treasurer.

The Lion constitution, written by Clair George and Alan Maloney, says in the preamble that its purpose is to explain political techniques and give each student an awareness of his position in campus politics.

#### Propose to Open Committee

The new constitution will be read and explained by Maloney. At the State Party meeting, Meyer Bushman, public relations

chairman, will give a talk on the history of the State Party and campus politics in general.

A proposal to expand the scope and representation of the State Party steering committee will be presented. The steering committee, according to present party plans, is to be open to all active members this year instead of the more or less closed group it has been in the past.

The steering committee of the Lion Party would be expanded by the proposed constitution by making every elected and appointed officer a member of it.

The major change in the present party setup for the Lions, to be provided by the new constitution, would be a preserving of the power of the party chairman. Many of his actions would be subject to approval of the new executive committee, to be made up of the four party officers, and each party class chairman.

### Theologian to Speak At Chapel Service

"On Being the Right Size" will be the topic of Dr. Halford E. Luccock at the Chapel services at 11 a.m. today in Schwab Auditorium. Dr. Luccock has been professor of preaching at the Yale University Divinity School for the past 24 years.

The Chapel Choir selections will be "Herzliebster Jesu" by Cruger, "Ye Watchers and Ye Holy Ones" arranged by Fischer, and "Cast Thy Burden Upon the Lord" by Mendelssohn.

George Ceiga, organist, will play "Fugue in A Minor" by Handel as prelude, "Abide, O Dearest Jesus" by Flor Peeters as offertory, and "Fantasia" by William Byrd as postlude.

Flowers will be provided by the Pi Kappa Alpha fraternity, which will attend the service in

a body. Dr. Luccock is a native of Pittsburgh. He is an ordained M.E. minister and has served pastorates in Windsor, Hartford, and New Haven, Conn. He was registrar and instructor in New Testament at Drew Theological Seminary, Madison, N.J., editorial secretary of the Methodist Board of Foreign Mission, and editor of the Christian Advocate.

Dr. Luccock received his B.A. from Northwestern University, B.D. from Union Theological Seminary, M.A. from Columbia University, D.D. from Syracuse University, Litt.D. from Allegheny College, B.D. from Wesleyan University, and D.D. from the University of Vermont. He is the author of many books.
